Organize Your Tools:

Keep tools in the right place to prevent damage and accidents. Knowing where everything is makes work smoother.

Use the Right Equipment:

Don't use tools for jobs they're not meant for. Use the right equipment to get the job done safely.

Emergency Plan:

Use things like fences and barriers to keep people away from dangerous areas.

Check Your Tools:

Before you start working, make sure your tools and equipment are in good shape.

Report Problems ASAP:

Encourage workers to report any issues or near-misses immediately. The quicker problems are known, the faster they can be fixed to avoid accidents.
